Enoch Rogers III (also known as Dinky) graduated from Edison High School in 1986 and worked as a youth basketball coach for the City of Stockton in the early '90s. Enoch loved all sports and could be found playing basketball weekly at St Mary's Church. In 2019, Enoch suddenly passed away after a tragic accident in his favorite location in downtown Stockton. Two days prior, he had been playing basketball, doing what he loved. Enoch's family recognized the need for organ and tissue donation for patients and made the generous decision to authorize organ and tissue donation. Enoch donated his left kidney and liver, saving the lives of two individuals.
